▶ **Optional Parent Orientation**



9-9:30A - Every Monday come get to know our staff & camp procedures! Let us know of any questions or special requests. We will do our very best to fulfill special requests but we can't promise to accommodate all of them.

▶ **Waiver Form**



Many camp registration forms get sent in without the mandatory Waiver forms having been completed properly! Waivers are good for the entire year during which it is completed (i.e. it's good for the year 2014 not necessarily for 12 months after you complete it). If you came to camp last year you need to complete a new waiver. If we don't have a current waiver on file, you'll *HAVE TO* fill one out at drop-off time Monday morning, no exceptions.

▶ **LUNCH, SNACKS, HAT, HELMET & LOTSA' WATER!!**



Be sure your child brings **LUNCH, SNACKS, HAT, HELMET & a LOT of WATER!** Due to liability, staff are not allowed to provide lunches to campers if they forget one and due to time constraints, a microwave is not available for heating everyone's lunches. Make sure to provide campers with water bottles that have a long strap to go everywhere they do! Also, your kid's bike helmet works great!

▶ **BOOTS**



We recommend campers wear **BOOTS** for foot safety! Save \$\$ by going to consignment stores to purchase used boots!

▶ **EXTRA CLOTHES**



Pack campers an **EXTRA** change of clothes! Clothes can get dirty, sweaty, wet or lost. Make sure to **LABEL ALL** belongings!

▶ **FABULOUS FRIDAY RODEOS**



Our **FABULOUS FRIDAY RODEOS** are from 3:30pm-5:30pm. Arrive at 3:20p for the 1800's western town tour. Rodeo begins at 4:00p.
